Summer River Sessions 2018

Again, Lynda Turner has emailed regarding the river sessions which will start on Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th May. When driving onto Castle Farm, please be aware this is a working farm and there will be animals including dogs running around. Please drive slowly onto the Farm (maximum 10 mph). It is also important that when booking yourself or a child in for the session, that you sign in and out; the signing-in sheet will normally be on Lynda's car.

Borrowing Club Equipment

Please be aware that every time you use a club boat, except when you have paid for a course, you should be paying for the use of that boat. It is £5.00 per day or £2.00 for a session. IN ADDITION, IF YOU TAKE ANY BOAT OR EQUIPMENT AWAY FROM THE FARM TO USE PRIVATELY, THEN YOU NEED PERMISSION FROM A COMMITTEE MEMBER AND THE BOAT MUST BE RETURNED PROMPTLY WITH PAYMENT. We would like to keep our charges small and to allow members to use the equipment therefore we would appreciate payment. There is a sheet inside the boat shed which should be completed and payment given to a Committee member.

Trips

We are planning to run some trips this year......further details will follow!

- **Cambridge** 24th June, depending on the weather. This will start at Grantchester and go through the city along the 'Backs' where the colleges line the river. If this trip doesn't happen on 24th June, we will try to find a suitable date later in the year.
- **Horstead/Buxton** two possible dates of 24th June or 22nd July, depending on whether or not the Cambridge trip takes place on 24th June.
- **Stour** overnight at Willowmere Caravan Park on 4th & 5th August which takes campers, £16 per night for two people.

Missing Equipment

We are currently missing an Ainsworth canoe paddle. Can you please check at home to see if anyone has this or any other DCG equipment that needs to be returned.

Weil's Disease

This can be caught when the urine from an infected animal enters freshwater and the infected water gets into your mouth, eyes or a cut. In Britain, Weil's disease is usually caught during water based activities such as kayaking, outdoor swimming or fishing.

To reduce the risk of infection:

- Before going on the water, ensure any cuts or grazes are covered with waterproof plasters
- After getting off the water wash your hands with soap and water as soon as possible and clean any wounds thoroughly

If you feel unwell, at all after being on the water, then please consult a doctor especially if you have a high temperature or a headache. Tell the doctor you have been canoeing. Weil's disease is caused by a bacterium and can be treated successfully with antibiotics.
