How information about you will be used

Personal information which you supply to Dereham Canoe Group may be used in a number of ways by both by us and British Canoeing, the sport's governing body to which we are affiliated, in compliance with relevant data protection legislation including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Personal data may be used, for example:

- To administer and manage your membership and related benefits. Your information will be held by us and may be shared with committee members for administrative purposes. It will be shared with British Canoeing who will hold it in a central membership\ database for this purpose. British Canoeing will give you the opportunity to ask for your information to be removed from its database if you wish.
- To review, develop and improve the services and activities offered by us and British Canoeing.
- To provide you with details of forthcoming activities, events, and competitions (as well as those of selected third parties (including our partner organisations).
- To research, develop and manage new and existing programs and projects and to promote our sport.
- To monitor British Canoeing's progress towards demonstrating equal opportunities in canoeing in England through the Equity Standards For Sport.
- For statistical analysis by British Canoeing.
- We may pass your personal information (which may include information about your health) to the insurer in the event of you/our club making an insurance claim. Information provided by you may be put onto a register of claims and shared with other insurers to prevent fraudulent claims. Dereham Canoe Group will retain your personal data for up to three years after your membership ceases for insurance purposes.

Photography

- Dereham Canoe Group uses photos taken during Group activities for publicity in print and on the internet, including the Group's Facebook page and website. By ticking the "Photo permission?" box beside your name or that of a junior member for whom you are responsible, you indicate that you grant permission for photos of this person to be used in this way.

Contacting you

- To deliver a quality service, the Group will need to communicate with members or a young member's parent/carer. We need to be able to tell you the information, that you need to know, so together we can participate in paddling activities. The Committee may also need to contact you about any last-minute changes to our plans. Will we also provide the Group's newsletter via email. Please speak to a Committee member to find out more.
